



****Once a "hot" wire travels through an object that uses energy,
it becomes a "neutral" wire****

What is a "Ground" wire and what color should it be?

What is the danger of switching the "hot" and "neutral" wire?

Basic rules:

14-gauge wire or thicker matches a 15A circuit

"Hot" attaches to Brass

"Neutral" attaches to Silver

Correct Stripping of wires

Clockwise wire loops when attaching to screws

Wires move only through conduit

Slack in the wires at the boxes

One wire per screw

Switches attach to "hot" wires
